It is a requirement that only those who meet the requirements below can enrol in this course.

Those requirements are that a person must:

- Be eligible for VET Student Loans (if applying to use VSL)
- Already hold a Commercial Licence (CPL)
- Hold a Class 1 medical and current ASIC
- At least 2 hours night flying including 1 hour solo.

The below non-tuition fees are **not** covered by VET Student Loans and must be covered by the student:
